

Freeborn Slave Certification

Champagne Co., Ohio, Dec. 22, 1841 in which the court clerk certifies that: "...Eliza Rector, aged about fourteen years, a negro person... was born in this state... and that by the Constitution and laws of this state... is a free person..."

The State of Ohio Champagne County of

I Jno C. Pearson Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid certify that Eliza Rector aged about fourteen years, a negro person, and daughter of Samuel & Charlotte Rector was born in this state, to wit in the County of Champagne aforesaid and has resided in said state from thence hitherto; and that ~~and~~ by the Constitution and laws of this state said Eliza Rector is a free person.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed the seal of said Court at Urbana this 22nd day of December 1841
