

# Supply Requisition for Colored Regiment

Civil War era document about "colored" regiment. Requisition for Stationery for the 17<sup>th</sup> US Colored Troops, dated July 1<sup>st</sup>, 1865, Nashville, Tennessee.

In this supply requisition, the 17<sup>th</sup> US Colored Troops request stationery items such as paper, envelopes, pens, tape and ink. Major Jos. E. Tuppen approves and signs the order twice, "Jos E Tuppen."
